INVITATION

The National Organizing Committee kindly invites you to take part in the work of the XXVIII International Scientific Symposium "METROLOGY AND METROLOGY ASSURANCE 2018" (XXVIII ISS "MMA 2018"), which will be held on September 10 – 14, 2018 in Sozopol town, Bulgaria.

The XXVIII International Scientific Symposium "METROLOGY AND METROLOGY ASSURANCE 2018" is organized by the Technical University of Sofia - Department "Electrical Measurements" and Department "Precision Engineering and Measurement Instruments". Co-organizers are Bulgarian Institute of Metrology, Union of the Metrologists in Bulgaria, Bulgarian Academical Association of Metrology and Kozloduy Nuclear Power Plant.

The ISS "MMA 2018" will provide insights to the latest achievements in metrology and metrology assurance. Traditional participants are representatives of state and private companies, metrological services, technical universities, licensed laboratories, international and Bulgarian measurement equipment companies.

The reports of ISS "MMA 2018" will be published in the Proceedings of XXVIII ISS "MMA 2018" in English in printed and in electronic form. The best report of young scientists (under 35) will be honored.

THE TOPICS OF THE SYMPOZIUM ARE:

- General aspects of metrology. Measurement methods. Unity and accuracy of measurements
- Sensors, transducers and devices for measurement of physical quantities
- Measurement and information systems and technologies
- Measurements in the industry
- Measurements in the electrical power engineering
- Acoustics measurements, vibration measurements and diagnostics
- Measurements in the ecology, biotechnology, medicine, and sport
- Measurement in the humanities and social science
- Quality management and control, standardization and certification

Working languages of the XXVIII ISS "MMA 2018":

The working languages of the Symposium are English, Bulgarian and Russian. On XXVIII ISS "MMA 2018" reports can be presented on each of the working languages at the request of the author/s. Translation services will be provided from and into any of the working languages.

Registration and submission reports for XXVIII ISS "MMA 2018"

1. The author/s of each report must have registration on the website of the ISS "MMA 2018" - <http://www.metrology-bg.org/>.
2. Application form for participation in the ISS "MMA 2018", accompanied by abstract should be submitted till 30.03.2018 on the website of the ISS "MMA 2018" - <http://www.metrology-bg.org/>.
3. The reports shall be submitted in English. Only for the reports that will be presented on one of the other two working languages (Bulgarian or Russian), is required submission of the report in both languages – English and a presentation language (Bulgarian or Russian) is required.
4. The authors of report will be notified of acceptance/rejection of the report till 15.04.2018.
5. The full report, prepared for publication, according to the instructions for authors on the website of the ISS "MMA 2018" till to 30.5.2018 should be uploaded on the website of the ISS "MMA 2018" in electronic form as two attachments files (file with the report in English and file with the report in the working language, on which it will be presented, not later than 30.5.2018).
6. All reports will be reviewed in accordance with the procedure and criteria set out in the website of the ISS "MMA 2018". Message of acceptance for the publication papers will be sent to the authors till 15.06.2018.
7. Only reports from the ISS "MMA 2018" (as printed proceedings and in electronic form) with paid registration fee to 15.07.2018 will be published. Not more than two reports may be published with one registration fee paid.
8. Upon registration all participants in ISS "MMA 2018" will be provided printed Proceedings of the ISS "MMA 2018" - in English, and a CD with all papers of ISS "MMA 2018" on the working language of presenting.

SOZOPOL

Sozopol is one of the oldest towns in Bulgaria, known as Apollonia Pontica. It was founded some 2600 years ago and is located at the Black Sea coast, 34 km. south of Burgas. The town has a rich historical and cultural heritage. Most of the buildings in the old part of the town
